



NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed Proposals for completion of the 2009 Scioto Audubon Metro Park Northern Tier Trail and Sitework as specified will be received by Metro Parks Headquarters, 1069 West Main Street, Westerville, Ohio 43081, until 1:00 p.m., local time, November 09, 2009, and at that time and place publicly opened and read. All bids will be considered valid until 60 days after opening date, although not accepted or rejected.

Copies of the Contract Bid Documents are available for review on the www.plankey.com website. The plans and specifications are available for purchase at Key Blueprints, 195 East Livingston Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The contract bid documents may be obtained for a non-refundable payment of \$20 per set. The Metro Parks will not be responsible for any plans and specifications obtained from any other source.

Each bid shall contain the full name and address of each person or company interested in the same and shall be accompanied by either:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 153.571; or
2. A certified check or cashier's check, made payable to "Metro Parks", or a letter of credit meeting the requirements of Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code, in the amount of ten (10) percent of the bid amount, on a solvent bank, conditioned to provide that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will enter into a proper contract for the work and provide the required bonds.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Central Activity Area, Scioto Audubon Metro Park 514 Furnace Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215 on November 4th, 2009 at 10:00am.

The bidder whose bid is accepted shall be required to enter into a contract within ten (10) days after notice of acceptance. This project requires a bond in the full amount of the bid for faithful completion of the contract. All bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes and clearly marked with the date and time of bid opening and the project title. Substantial completion of this contract shall be within 120 calendar days of the date of contract signing. The cost of this project has been estimated to be approximately \$350,000. Metro Parks, or their designated agents will inspect the work under this contract.

Metro Parks reserves the right to accept the lowest and most responsive bid, the right to waive irregularities in any proposal, the right to accept the proposal which promotes the best interest of the Board, and the right to reject any and all bids or any part thereof.
